We are truly delighted by the results of the Class of 2020, a cohort who faced unprecedented challenges in their matric year. 75% of the girls achieved Level 6 or 7 aggregates, and 29% of all individual subject marks were 80% and above. In total, 87% of all our results were a Level 5, 6 or 7, and this speaks to the drive and self-belief of each girl who determinedly pursued her academic 'personal bests'.
