One Dorothy Height, civil rights and women's rights activist says, "You never teach a subject, you always teach a child."

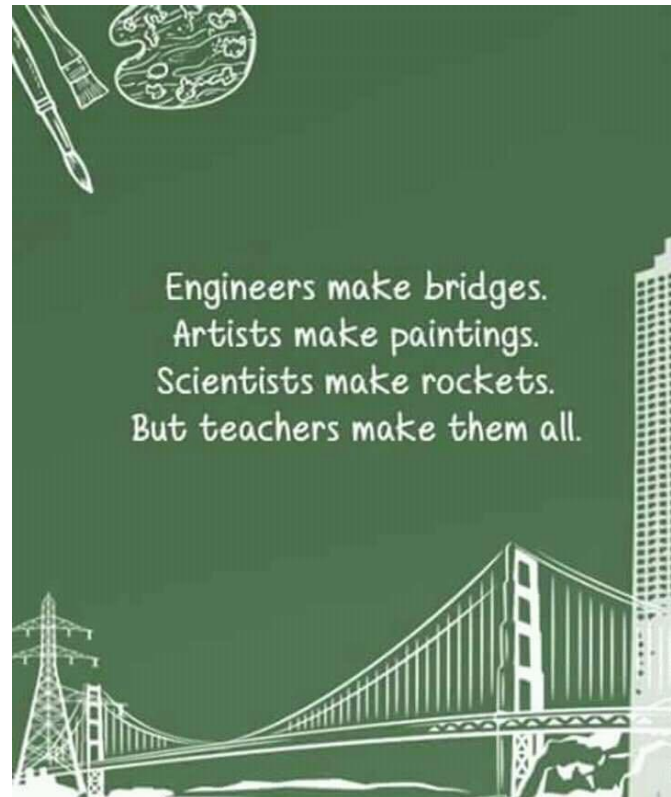
Working in a school can be a tough job. It is also one of the most important roles in society. We as teachers feel pride in our chosen profession.
